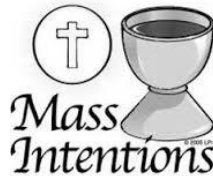

CONGRATULATIONS TO JORDAN GLENEWICZ AND HIS PARENTS MARK AND CHRISTINE

This Sunday Jordan Gleniewicz will receive the outstanding status of Eagle Scout through our parish scout troop # 109. Jordan has been actively involved in our parish community since he was a child and we are so very proud of him for this wonderful honor he receives today.

On Sunday June 5th Jordon Gleniewicz will receive his Eagle Scout Award, the highest rank in Boy Scouting at his Eagle Court of Honor.

Jordon's Eagle Project was the construction of a prayer labyrinth located on the grounds of St. Matthews. He designed this labyrinth in the form of a maze-like path, contained within a large circle. The winding circular pathway measures three-feet wide and is lined with wood chips and brick borders leading to a tall wooden cross at the exact center. Near the entrance, a small footbridge was also built to provide easy access for entering the site. Jordon built this labyrinth to provide parishioners with an alternative and creative way to pray and reach out to God, as well as reflect and meditate. Retreat groups are also able to utilize this for activities and prayer.

A senior at Randolph High School, Jordon has always had a passionate interest in Art History and has completed an independent study in this field over the past year. He will continue this journey at Montclair State University, majoring in Fine Arts and an Art History concentration.

As a dedicated Catholic Scout, he has earned the Ad Altari Dei and Pope Pius XII scouting awards. He has served as an Altar Server and leader in youth retreats during his Confirmation years. Jordon has enjoyed volunteering to serve those who need shelter, food and clothing via Bridges outreach programs and the St. Matt's food pantry.

Jordon extends thanks to the entire parish of St. Matthews for their encouragement, support and love during his journey. He continues to keep all in his prayers throughout life and encourages all to use the labyrinth for reflection on their own life journey.
