## Retirement For Religious 2017

On November 4<sup>th</sup> of this Year I attended a funeral Mass in Newburg NY for a Dominican Sister of Hope, Sister Lorraine Gallagher. She gave her entire life to the education of children and for 11 of those years I was Chaplain with her at St. Christopher School in Parsippany (now part of All Saints Academy). She had a great impact on the children entrusted to her care and helped form them in their faith and educational pursuits.

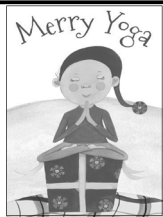
In reminds me of the impactful role that all religious have had in the Catholic Church in a variety of ministries including education.

For all that they gave to us, Catholics have an opportunity to give back to the religious who have touched their lives in some way when the Retirement Fund for Religious is taken up at all weekend Masses Dec. 9-10 in the Diocese of Paterson. Proceeds are distributed to eligible congregations to help underwrite retirement and health-care expenses.

The 2016 appeal raised more than \$30 million nationally. Last year, the parishioners in the Diocese of Paterson contributed \$298,009.94 of that total amount. While support from the Retirement Fund for Religious has helped many religious communities to stabilize retirement accounts, hundreds of others continue to lack sufficient resources to fully provide for older members.

Therefore, I please ask that you remember a religious who has been an important part of your life, and give as your means allow to the Retirement for Religious. Thank you.
