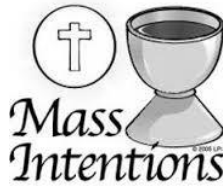

**BAPTISM:** Families are requested to contact the Parish Office for details on pre-baptismal instruction and date of Baptism.

**FAITH FORMATION:** Faith Formation for children kindergarten thru 11<sup>th</sup> grade takes place on Sundays and Wednesdays, (Confirmation Sunday evenings) Please contact Moira Dziomba at 862-251-4129 with any questions.

**LOW GLUTEN EUCHARIST:** As a reminder, for those parishioners or visitors who have Celiac Disease or have an allergy to gluten in food products, we offer gluten-free hosts for Eucharist. ***If you desire to receive this host, we ask that you notify the Deacon at least 5 minutes before Mass in order that we can prepare for the special host for the Mass.***

**RECONCILIATION:** The Sacrament of Reconciliation will be celebrated each Saturday from 4:15-4:45PM before the evening Liturgy or by appointment at another time.

**RITE OF CHRISTIAN INITIATION (RCIA):** RCIA prepares adolescents and adults for Baptism and full Communion into the Catholic Church. Please call the office for more information.

**THE EUCHARIST AT HOME:** Holy Communion may be brought to the home of any person permanently or temporarily homebound. For the confined, the elderly and/or shut-in, be they at home or in the hospital, the staff of our parish makes calls to homes and hospitals each month. ## **BAPTISM PREPARATION PROGRAM**

St. Matthew's consists of a team of very faithful and committed young couples who welcomes Baptism parents into their homes. This program is the beginning of the child's journey towards full initiation into the Catholic Church. The overall focus of the program is to offer the opportunity to deepen one's faith commitment, to better understand the gift and challenge of Christian parenting and to come together to find support in knowing other young couples of our parish. The Team coordinators are Chris and Lori Arends.

The process is as follows:

- **When new parents call the parish office to schedule a Baptism they will provide the Baptismal information and set the date for the Baptism (they will have a choice of having their child Baptized during a weekend Mass or after Mass on Sunday afternoon). The Team Coordinators assign a Baptismal Preparation Couple to the family and they will receive a call to schedule a time and date for the meeting. The meeting will take place at the home of one of the team couples. Parents are encouraged to bring their children with them. The meeting will include the shared experiences of the team couple related to Baptism, the importance of naming the child, the roles of the parents and godparents in Baptism, a short video presentation, refreshments and discussion.**
- **Following this meeting the Baptism couple will be contacted by Fr. Dan or one of the Deacons to schedule a brief meeting, at the couples' home which will further explain the actual Rite of Baptism to be held at the church.**

## **PARISH WELCOME – ORIENTATION MEETING**

St. Matthew's Parish is gifted with an increasing number of new people coming forth wanting to join our community. What a blessing this is! If you would like to register at St. Matthews, after Mass, please introduce yourself to Fr. Dan, Deacon Ed or Deacon Rich and ask them for a Pre-registration card. After your card is received by the Parish Office, you will be sent a Welcome Letter and full Registration form; which you will return when you attend the New Parishioner Welcome Meeting, or if you wish, a home visit can be set up.

St. Matthews has found that this new process will enable parishioners to be welcomed into our Parish Family while also presenting Fr. Dan the opportunity to get to know you and your family. By taking the time and effort in helping people to know and understand about the various ministries offered, we are confident that new parishioners will be encouraged to become active in St. Matthew's parish life. The next Welcome Meeting is Tuesday, September 20<sup>th</sup> at 7:30PM.
