## ONLINE GIVING - WeShare Transitioning from ParishPay

Our current online giving provider, ParishPay, has been acquired by WeShare. **All ParishPay accounts will be transitioned to WeShare on Monday, October 9th.**

The security of your personal information is important to us. WeShare requires a one-time security verification to provide you access.

**To successfully complete the verification process you will need:**

1. Your ParishPay User Name
2. The last four digits of the bank account or credit card that is currently being used for your donations
3. And ONE of the following two options:
  - The email you used to register with ParishPay
  - A collection name and the specific amount donated in the last six months

Once verification is complete, you will receive a confirmation email with a link to our new WeShare site. Please bookmark or save this link for future access.

Thank you for using online giving to support our parish. Online giving is safe, simple, and convenient. The practice of Christian stewardship in doing online giving provides the opportunity for planned giving in what we offer back to God. It benefits our parish by helping to streamline our administrative process and at the same time provides more accurate budgeting. It was wonderful welcoming back the children to Faith Formation! This year we have almost 400 children enrolled in Faith Formation from K-11.

The classrooms are alive with activity once again and the church is filled with a "Joyful Noise"! How blessed we are at St. Matthew's to have such a vibrant community!

In the high school evening session 10<sup>th</sup> and 11<sup>th</sup> graders were welcomed back to class. They will continue with the video series entitled, *Chosen: Your Journey Toward Confirmation*.

The goal of the program is to offer the confirmation candidates a powerful, life changing experience as they prepare to receive the Sacrament of Confirmation.

Meanwhile, in Heritage Hall we held Confirmation Orientation for our 9<sup>th</sup> graders, where they were introduced to *Chosen* a two and a half year journey toward becoming adult members of the Catholic Church.

On September 21<sup>st</sup>, our 11<sup>th</sup> graders attended their Confirmation retreat. The BREATHE retreat is peer run, given by high school seniors who celebrated Confirmation last year for the upcoming Confirmation class. This is an opportunity for the candidates to get away from the day to day grind. It enables them to understand, deepen and share their faith. It was a blessing for Fr. Sean and me to be able to share this day with our St. Matthew's teens.



### BLESSING OF PETS SUNDAY, OCTOBER 8 AFTER THE 11 AM MASS

As autumn arrives, people in various places may notice something odd. A procession of animals, everything from dogs and cats to hamsters and even horses, is led to churches for a special ceremony called the Blessing of Pets. This custom is conducted in remembrance of Saint Francis of Assisi's love for all creatures.

Francis, whose feast day is October 4th, loved the larks flying about his hilltop town. He and his early brothers, staying in a small hovel, allowed themselves to be displaced by a donkey. Francis wrote a Canticle of the Creatures, an ode to God's living things. "All praise to you, Oh Lord, for all these brother and sister creatures." And there was testimony in the cause for Saint Clare of Assisi's canonization that referred to her little cat!

For single householders, a pet can be a true companion. Many people arrive home from work to find a furry friend overjoyed at their return. Many a senior has a lap filled with a purring fellow creature. The bond between person and pet is like no other relationship, because the communication between fellow creatures is at its most basic. Eye-to-eye, a man and his dog, or a woman and her cat, are two creatures of love.
